Paul Hunt, his heirs and assigns:--

All the right, title and interest which the grantors inherited from Blythe Hunt, deceased, that interest being a one-twentieth (1/20) interest each in the following described tracts of land:--

All that piece, parcel or tract of land situated, lying and being in the County of Greenville, said State, adjoining lands of F. P. Newby Estate of Henry Lynch and others, and containing eighty-five and one-half (85½) acres, more or less. Said land sold to C. B. Tarrant by D. P. Verner, Master, by deed recorded in the office of the R. M. C. for said County in Book EEE at page 12; less, however, 11¼ acres, more or less, sold by Eula Hunt to A. E. Edwards by deed dated January 6, 1903, and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, S. C., in Deed Book JJJ, at page 233.
