(1) All that certain tract of land in Paris Mt. Township containing 8.34 acres, more or less, being more fully described in deed to me from Robert M. Carter and Helen V. Carter November 2nd, 1933, recorded in the Office of R. M. C. , County and State aforesaid, in Book 176 1/2 at page 125, and being also the same tract conveyed to Robert M. Carter, et al by Othella A. Hughes (now Thornley) by deed dated March 6th, 1932, recorded in said office in Book 160, at page 220, and being the same tract conveyed by A. S. Mauldin to William H. Hughes and B. B. Hughes by deed recorded in said office in Book 89, page 180, the description of said 8.34 acres tract in said three deeds being here incorporated by reference for metes and bounds.

(2) Also that certain lot of land in Paris Mt. Township, County and State aforesaid, containing 2.66 acres, more or less, being part of tract of land of 13.9 acres, more or less, conveyed to Robert M. Carter, Lucille C. Carter and Helen V. Carter by deed dated March 6th, 1932, recorded in said office in Book 160 at page 220, and being the same tract of 13.9 acres originally conveyed to A. B. Hughes by W. C. Beacham, by deed dated September 22nd, 1922, recorded in said office in Book 75, at page 317, the metes and bounds of this tract being as follows, as appears from the plat of C. M. Furman, Jr., dated November 4th, 1933.

Beginning at a sweet gum corner near the line of said larger tract of 13.9 acres, running thence S. 8-15 E. 572 ft. to an iron pin; thence N. 65 W. 200 ft. to an iron pin; thence N. 12-15 W. 454 ft. to an iron pin on road; thence along the middle of the road N. 73-35 E. 100 ft. to an iron pin in road; thence N. 82-35 E. 100 ft. to an iron pin in road; thence about ten (10 ft.) feet to the beginning corner.
