in the State aforesaid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release, unto the said
Melzema G. Martin,

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Paris Mountain, Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina.

Beginning at a stone 3x on Saluda River (in place of a Beech gone); thence N. 66 E. 20.50 to a stone 3x in branch; thence up the meanders of said branch to a stone 3x; thence N. 67 E. 11.40 to a stone 3x; thence N. 29 E. 8.80 to a stone 3x; thence N. 68 W. 75 links to a stone 3x; thence N. 88 W. 27.00 to a Dogwood 3x; thence N. 16 W. 6.60 to a white oak 3x; thence N. 72 W. 23.25 to a stone 3x in Armstrong Creek; thence N. 29 E. 1.65 to a stone 3x; thence N. 39 W. 5.10 at Saluda River; thence down the meanderings of said River to the beginning corner, containing 184 acres, more or less, all of which will fully appear by reference to a plat of said land made by W. M. Hunt, Surveyor, bearing date the 24th day of Feb. A.D. 1886.

Also, all that other piece, parcel and tract of land situate, lying and being in the County and State aforesaid, Beginning at the mouth of a ditch that empties in Armstrong Creek; thence up the meanderings of said Creek to a Beech 3x; thence N. 13 1/2 E. 3.27 to a sweet gum 3x; thence N. 87 1/2 W. 12.00 to a pine 3x; thence N. 68 1/2 W. 3.50 to a white oak 3x; thence N. 62-2/3 W. 3.80 to a persimmon 3x at ditch; thence down said ditch to the beginning corner, containing 12 acres, more or less.
