Personally appeared before me J. Frank Epps who being duly sworn deposes and says that he is a duly licensed attorney at law having for a number of years practiced his profession in the City of Greenville, State and County aforesaid;

Deponent states that he clearly recalls having witnessed and probated a deed in the summer of 1933 in which deed E. E. Sullivan conveyed a tract of 154 acres more or less situated in Glassy Mountain Township to S. L. Odum; that he well remembers the date of such transaction for the reason that in order to close the transaction it was necessary that the grantee S. L. Odum, execute a note and mortgage in the amount of twelve hundred and fifty dollars, which mortgage was executed by said S. L. Odum to deponent as Attorney, and recorded in the R.M.C. Office of Greenville Co. in Vol 244, page 114.

Deponent states that he has observed that as recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville Co., the date of the deed referred to above is given as July 11th, 1930, though the date of execution showed July 11, 1933; that this date of deed as recorded is an error due probably to deponent's inadvertently failing to type the word "Three" after "Nineteen Thirty."

Deponent states that he has no interest in this matter now except to see to it that an error of date which is of record be corrected; that he is making this affidavit with the request of the Register of Merce Connerance that the error be corrected by changing on the record the day of the deed above referred to to the correct date, i.e. July 11, 1933.
