

Power of Attorney.

Know all men by these presents: That Reconstruction Finance Corporation, a corporation organized and existing under and by virtue of an Act of Congress entitled "Reconstruction Finance Corporation Act", approved January 22, 1932, hereby and by these presents does make, constitute, and appoint, John A. Campbell, Jr., of the City of Charlotte, County of Mecklenburg, State of North Carolina, its true and lawful attorney for it and in its name and stead:

(1) To satisfy, discharge or release, by appropriate instrument, or in any manner authorized by statute, any chattel mortgage, real estate mortgage, or other instrument creating a lien which secures any note, bond, or other evidence of indebtedness held by said Reconstruction Finance Corporation.

(2) To assign by appropriate instrument and without representation, recourse, or warranty any chattel mortgage, real estate mortgage, or other instrument creating a lien which secures any note, bond, or other evidence of indebtedness held by said Reconstruction Finance Corporation.

Further giving and granting unto its said attorney John A. Campbell, Jr., of the City of Charlotte, County of Mecklenburg, State of North Carolina, full power and authority to do and to perform all and every act and thing requisite, necessary, and proper to be done for effecting the premises herein contained, and hereby ratifying and confirming all that its said attorney shall lawfully do or cause to be done by virtue of these presents.
