For value received, each from the other, the parties hereto do hereby agree to, and do, amend the lease between Clinton J. Morgan and Jas. H. Morgan, Jr., individually and as trustee under the will of Jas. H. Morgan, deceased, parties of the first part, and Payne Oil Company, party of the second part, which said lease is dated the 6th day of February, 1930, and said amendments to be as follows:

In Lines 5 and 6 in Paragraph 4 of said lease, wherever the words and figures "three hundred twenty-five and no/100 (\$325.00) dollars" occur therein, in lieu thereof insert the following: "three hundred (\$300.00) dollars per month from January 1, 1932, through the 30th day of June, 1932, and thereafter three hundred twenty-five (\$325.00) dollars."

And at the foot of Paragraph 6, Page 2, the following: "Provided the lessees may submit that portion of the Bull Stake, proper, which is included in said lease to such sub-lessee as the lessors may approve and provided, further, that in the event of any sub-lease under the terms of the lease, such sub-lease shall not release the lessees from any obligation contained in said lease."

This amendment to be also signed by Peoples Oil Company, by its proper officers, and that said Peoples Oil Company is a party of said lease the same as if it had been originally named therein and executed the same, and for value received, it hereby binds itself and its successors to and by all of the terms and conditions of this amendment and of said lease.

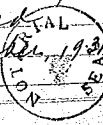
