Known All Men by these Presents:

Whereas, by deed dated on the 1st day of February, 1928, and filed for record in the Office of the R. M. C. of the County of Greenville, on the 27th day of February, 1928, L. W. Simpson did convey to Union Trust Company of Maryland and the South Carolina National Bank of Charleston, Trustees, the property therein described, to secure the payment of certain indebtedness set out in the said Deed of Trust, and
