Court For The Southern District of New York:

The petition of George B. Compton respectfully shows
to this Court and alleges:

1. That your petitioner was temporarily appointed
Trustee of the estate of Interstate Mortgage Company, by an
order made and entered herein on August 6, 1934; that
said appointment was duly made permanent by an
order made herein on September 6, 1934; and that your
petitioner is now acting in that capacity.

2. That Interstate Mortgage Company was the owner
in fee simple of certain real property located in the
City of Greenville, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina,
designated on the records of the Company by Loan No. MB-
1447, more fully described as follows:

All that tract or parcel of land situate, lying and
being in the County and State aforesaid, in Ward No.
(6) of the City of Greenville, having the following metes and
bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at an iron pin 65 feet from the intersec-
