Joseph L. Tinsley and Savannah Tinsley
All that piece parcel and tract of land lying
situate and being in the State and County aforesaid
and Bates Township.

With the following metes and bounds to wit:
Beginning on a stone, a corner between J. F. Kuest and
myself, and running S. 35¹¹ W. 2:20 Chains to a stone,
N. W. Thence S 88²⁴ W. 42:26 Chains to a stone N. W.
Thence N. 56²⁴ W. 2:90 Chains to a Poplar O. W. at a Spring;
thence N. 39³⁴ W. 8:00 Chains to an Ashe (now down).
This corner should be on a Seven Bark tree which
stands at the side where the Ashe did stand.
This corner was formerly on the north side of a
small branch emptied into North Saluda River,
at this point, but the branch has been turned by
men to empty in to the river, about 5:50 Chains
up the river from this corner. Thence from the Ashe
corner a northeasterly course the line runs up North
Saluda River 17:00 Chains to the mouth of a small
branch and corners on a small maple with A. J. Bates;
thence from the River the line runs up the meandering
of branch 9:44 Chains to a stone O. W. on the south side of
the branch. Thence S. 22³⁴ E. 10:00 Chains to a stone O. W.
Thence S. 67⁴ W. 5²⁵ Chains to a stone O. W. Thence S. 9⁴ E.
6:84 Chains to a stone and the beginning corner.
