Beginning at an iron pin on the Laurel Creek Church line, and running thence S. 77.15 E. 591 feet to pin on the south side of Laurens Road 25 feet from the center of said road; thence along the road 25 feet from the center of same N. 45-048 W. 180.5 feet to a bend; thence N. 53-40 W. 207.6 feet to bend; thence N. 63 W. 251 feet to iron pin; thence S. 13-30 W. 240 feet to the beginning corner, and containing 2.28 acres."
