All of our right, title and interest in and to all that certain piece, parcel or tract of land situate, lying and being in Greenville County, State of South Carolina, and having the following metes and bounds to-wit:

Beginning at an iron pin in fork of the Old Saluda Road and the road leading to the home of Q. A. Morrison on Tubbs Mountain, thence N. 71½ E. 10.98 chs. to an iron pin on edge of stream and at the root of Sweet Gum; thence S. 33 E. 5.00 chs. to iron pin 50 links below spring; which is four feet west of line; thence N. 67 E. 20.00 chs. to iron pin in field; thence S. 33 E. 6.54 chs. to stone; Harry Poole and G. W. Bovers corner; thence N. 63½ E. 7.56 to old oak stump on edge of Tubbs Branch; thence N. 64 W. 14.03 to iron pin, Q. A.
