A. Forrester's corner); thence N. 55¾ E. 29.83 to stone; thence N. 59½ W. 4.00 to sweet gum; thence N. 76 W. 1.50 to sweet gum; thence S. 80 W. 8.25 to Pine; thence N. 25 W. 5.80 to the beginning corner; containing 48½ acres, more or less, adjoining lands of Jackson Brown, Rothchild, I.
