in the State aforesaid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release, unto the said Frank Williams

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina.

conveyed to George W. Sistine by Louisa Pickens, May 21, 1915, recorded in R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Book 10, page 170, and which was inherited by me and Nana M. L. Sistine from the said George W. Sistine under his will, and the said Nana M. L. Sistine conveyed her interest to me June 30, 1930, deed being recorded in R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Book 152, page 258, and described as follows.

In the rear of lots fronting on the south side of Stone Avenue, and between Milton and Rutherford Streets, Beginning at an iron pin on the east side of an alley and running thence N. 20 E. 82 feet to a stake; thence N. 87 1/2 W. 329 feet and 4 inches to a stake; thence S. 17 E. 148 feet and 5 inches to a mulberry stump; thence N. 80 E. 253 feet crossing an alley to the beginning corner.

The above is known as the Noble William lot.
