in the State aforesaid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release, unto the said South Carolina State Commission of Forestry, its successors and assigns :

That piece, parcel or lot of land in Chick Springs Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, which was conveyed to David Parker by Eugene Batson, deed dated December 10, 1914, recorded in Deed Book 10, page 448, also by J. Inman, Master, to David Parker, April 6, 1925, deed recorded in Deed Book 110, page 33. Said land lies on Mountain Creek of Enoree River and on the northeast side of Paris Mountain. Excepted from this conveyance are the tracts heretofore conveyed to James R. Smith, containing 29 1/2 acres, and 7 acres conveyed to C. R. Nesbitt, and one acre conveyed to Ella Thompson. All deeds hereinabove referred to are recorded in the R. M. C. Office for said Greenville County.

This deed conveys all the land that I own in Chick Springs Township, in said County and State, and the tract herein conveyed contains 54 acres be the same more or less.
