KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS That I, Wycliffe Robinson,

in the State aforesaid.  
in consideration of the sum of one (\$1.00) DOLLARS

to me now in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by  
Sula Belle Wright:

in the State aforesaid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release, unto the said  
Sula Belle Wright:

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina.

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land with the buildings and improvements situate thereon, lying and being in Greenville Township, Greenville County, South Carolina, near the corporate limits of the City of Greenville, on the east side of McDonald Street, known and designated as lot No. 84 of North Hills property, and having, according to plat thereof which is recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, S. C., in Plat Book H, at page 138, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:-

Beginning at an iron pin on the east side of McDonald Street, which iron pin is at the joint corner of lots 84 and 85, and running thence with the line of said lots, S. 71-43 W. 198.3 feet to an iron pin on the west side of a 20 foot alley; thence with the west side of said Alley, N. 18-34 E. 70 feet to an iron pin at the rear corner of lots 83 and 84; thence with the joint line of said lots, N. 71-43 W. 198.3 feet to an iron pin on McDonald Street; thence with the east side of said Street, S. 23-32 W. 70.2 feet to the beginning corner.

This is the identical property conveyed by me to Sula Belle Wright, the grantee herein, by deed dated September 29, 1933, and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Deeds, Volume 115, at page 536, but said deed contained a defective probate thereto and the purpose of this deed is to correct same and to dispose of any question that might arise on account thereof.
