do hereby give, sell, bargain, sell and release, unto the said
Sunice Lee Satterfield,

all that piece of land or parcel of land situated on the West side of Laurens Road in said State and
County 3 1/2 miles from Greenville Courthouse, containing two and one-half acres more or
less, and with such bounds, marks, etc., as follows, viz: Beginning on a stone by 2
small black gums; thence along Laurens Road N. 3 1/2 W. 5.50 to a stake; thence N. 22 1/2 W.
2.38 to a stake; thence S. 43 W. 5.00 to a stone; thence S. 5 1/2 E. 6.87 to a stone;
thence N. 57 1/2 E. 2.15 to the beginning. Being bounded by lands now or formerly owned
by S. L. McBee, J. A. Tolbert, and T. L. Hunt, and being the same land conveyed to me
by Josephine Smith by deed dated October 10, 1930, and recorded in the office of the
Register of Deeds Conveyance for Greenville County in Deed Book 163, at page 105.

The said Josephine Smith, who reserved a life estate in the deed executed by her
