Beginning at an iron pin on Patterson Street, 130 feet from the intersection of Patterson and Lee Streets, at corner of lot 20, and running thence along line of lot 20, S. 44 E. 117.9 feet to iron pin; thence S. 46-55 W. 65.15 feet to iron pin on line of lot 18; thence along line of lot 18, N. 44 W. 117.8 feet to iron pin on Patterson Street; thence along Patterson Street N. 46 E. 65 feet to the beginning corner.
