TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS SHALL COME:

I, E. INMAN, Master in and for the County aforesaid, SEND GREETINGS:

WHEREAS, Mrs. M. B. Rudd,

on or about the 12th day of June in the year of our Lord nineteen hundred and thirty three exhibited her complaint in the County Court of XXXXXXXX in the County aforesaid against Edith Greene Coyle,

demanding judgment in relation to the real estate hereinafter mentioned and described; and the cause being at issue, came on to be heard on the 9th day of February 1933 and such proceedings were had therein as resulted in a Decree

of the said Court whereby it was adjudged and decreed that the said real estate hereinafter mentioned and described be sold by E. INMAN, Master in and for the County aforesaid in conformity with the provisions contained in the said Decree, a copy of which reference thereto on file in said Court will appear; and th. Master, after having duly advertised the said real estate

to be sold by public auction on the 5th day of March in the year of our Lord nineteen hundred and thirty four did then openly and publicly, according to the custom of auctions, sell and dispose of the same unto Bub Moon,

for the sum of One Hundred (\$100.00) Dollars, being at that price the highest bidder therefor.

NOW, THEREFORE, Know All Men by These Presents, that I, E. INMAN, Master in and for the County of Greenville, aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of One Hundred (\$100.00) Dollars to me paid by the said Bub Moon,

the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, HAVE GRANTED, bargained, sold, and released, and by these Presents DO GRANT, bargain, sell and release unto the said Bub Moon,

"All that tract of land situate, lying and being in Chick Springs Township, County and State aforesaid, near Paris, and containing 23 acres, more or less, as shown on a plat made by W. M. Rast, of the office of C. M. Furman, Jr., on May 8, 1926, and designated on said plat as property of Edith Greene Coyle, and having the following metes and bounds, and courses and distances, as shown by said plat:

Beginning at an iron pin, at or near the northeast corner of said tract, in or near where one plantation road connects with another plantation road, and running thence N. 18-50 W. 155.8 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 39-50 W. 156 feet to and iron pin; thence S. 26-40 W. 3918 feet to an iron pin; thence S. S. 65-05 E. 249 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 28-20 E. 3765 feet to the beginning corner.

This being the same tract of land conveyed by Edward Greene to Edith Greene Coyle May 13, 1926, By deed recorded in Book 128, page 15, R. M. C. office for Greenville County." The grantee, Bub Moon is to pay the 1934 taxes.
