COURT OF COMMON PLEAS.

TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS SHALL COME:

I, E. INMAN, Master in and for the County aforesaid, SEND GREETINGS:

WHEREAS, American Building and Loan Association, a Corporation,

on or about the 15th day of November in the year of our Lord nineteen hundred and thirty three exhibited its complaint in the Court of Common Pleas, for the County aforesaid, against (Mrs.) Lois W. Campbell

demanding judgment in relation to the real estate hereinafter mentioned and described; and the cause being at issue, came on to be heard on the 17th day of August 1934, and such proceedings were had therein as resulted in a Decree

of the said Court, whereby it was adjudged and decreed that the said real estate hereinafter mentioned and described be sold by E. INMAN, Master in and for the County aforesaid, on the terms and for the purposes mentioned in the said decree, as by reference thereto on file in said Court will appear; and the Master, after having duly advertised the said real estate

for sale by public entry on the 3rd day of September in the year of our Lord nineteen hundred and thirty four did then openly and publicly, according to the custom of auctions, sell and dispose of the same unto American Building and Loan Association, a Corporation

for the sum of One Hundred (\$100.00) Dollars, being at that price the highest bidder thereof.

NOW, THEREFORE, Know All Men by these Presents, That I, E. INMAN, Master in and for the County of Greenville, aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of One Hundred (\$100.00) Dollars to me paid by the said American Building and Loan Association, a corporation

the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, HAVE GRANTED, bargained, sold, and released, and by these Presents DO GRANT, bargain, sell and release unto the said American Building and Loan Association, a corporation

"All that piece, parcel or lot of land lying and being in Greenville County, South Carolina, near the Laurens Road and designated as part of lots Nos. 73 and 74 of the subdivision of Eastover as shown by Plat of record in Plat Book "F", Page 42, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at an iron pin on the north side of Arden Street, corner of Lot No. 72, which pin is 258.3 feet from intersection of Arden and Pace Streets, and running thence with line of Lot No. 72, N. 25-30 W. 100 feet to a stake in line of Lot No. 73; thence with line of lot No. 75 N. 64-30 E. 70 feet to a stake; thence S, 25-30 E. 100 feet to a stake on Arden Street; thence with Arden Street S. 64-30 W. 70 feet to the beginning corner, being the same conveyed to Lois W. Campbell by Whelthy V. Borogns by deed dated September 7, 1932."
