Forty Five Hundred (\$4500.00) Dollars
to me paid by the said Pauline S. Arnold,

the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, HAVE GRANTED, bargained, sold, and released, and by these Presents DO GRANT, bargain, sell and release unto the said
Pauline S. Arnold,

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in
the County and State aforesaid, on the South side of Buncombe Street, and having the
following metes and bounds: to-wit: beginning at the corner of Lot known as Cowart's
lot and running thence N. 34 W. 60 feet with Buncombe Street to a pin; thence S.
56 W. 150 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 34 E. 60 feet to an iron pin; thence N.
