NOW, THEREFORE, Know All Men by These Presents, That I, E. INMAN, Master in and for the County of Greenville, aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of  
Twelve hundred Fifty (\$ 1250.00) Dollars  
to me paid by the said  
Lillie A. Nash

the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, HAVE GRANTED, bargained, sold, and released, and by these Presents DO GRANT, bargain, sell and release unto the said  
Lillie A. Nash:

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, about one mile from the incorporation limits of the City of Greenville, near the Paris Mountain Road, containing one-half acre, more or less, and having the following metes and bounds:  
Beginning at an iron pin on the north side of the road leading to the Society Grounds, and running thence with Society Grounds N. 19° 21' 128.7 feet to iron pin in line of W. H. Irvine, thence with Irvine line S. 71° 21' 16.5 feet to iron pin (which pin is 16.5 feet from cedar tree); thence S. 19° E. 129.6 feet, more or less, to iron pin in road leading to Society Grounds; and thence with said road N. 70° E. 16.5 feet to the beginning corner.
