the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, HAVE GRANTED, bargained, sold, and released, and by these Presents DO GRANT, bargain, sell and release unto the said
John A. Park

on Meadow Fork Creek, and together containing 86 acres, more or less, having metes and
