NOW, THEREFORE, Know All Men by These Presents, That I, E. INMAN, Master in and for the County of Greenville, aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of  
**One Hundred (\$100.00)** ..... Dollars  
to me paid by the said **Catherine Coughlin,**

the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, HAVE GRANTED, bargained, sold, and released, and by these Presents DO GRANT, bargain, sell and release unto the said  
**Catherine Coughlin,**

"All that lot or parcel or land, situate, lying and being in Greenville Township  
Greenville County, South Carolina, on the Cox Bridge Road, on the south side of said road;  
and having the following courses and distances:

Beginning at a stake on Cox Bridge Road 52.5 feet southeast of Lot No. 4, as  
shown on plat of property of Samuel M. Cox and running thence S. 34 W. 220.8 feet to  
stake on Southern Cotton Oil Mill Road; thence with said road N. 76-26 E. 77.5 feet,
