TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS SHALL COME:
I, E. INMAN, Master in and for the County aforesaid, SEND GREETINGS:
WHEREAS, Atlantic Life Insurance Company,

on or about the 19th day of February in the year of our Lord nineteen hundred and thirty five exhibited its complaint in the Court of Common Pleas for the County aforesaid against Thos. L. Lewis, et al.

Remanding judgment in relation to the real estate hereinafter mentioned and described, and the cause being at issue, came on to be heard on the 10th day of April 1935 and such proceedings were had therein as resulted in a Decree

of the said Court, whereby it was adjudged and decreed that the said real estate hereinafter mentioned and described be sold by E. for the sum of Five hundred (\$500.00) Dollars, being at that price the highest bidder therefor.

NOW, THEREFORE, Know All Men by These Presents, That I, E. INMAN, Master in and for the County of Greenville, aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of Five Hundred (\$500.00) Dollars to me paid by the said Atlantic Life Insurance Company, a Corporation

the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, HAVE GRANTED, bargained, sold, and released, and by these Presents DO GRANT, bargain, sell and release unto the said Atlantic Life Insurance Company, a Corporation,

"All that piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, and being known and designated as Lot No. 15 on Plat No. 1 of Park Hill, property of Mrs. J. O. Lewis, which plat is recorded in the R. L. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book "F", page 136, and having according to a plat thereof prepared by Willard & Bleckley, Engineers, August, 1926, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at an iron pin at the Southeast corner of the intersection of Conestee Avenue and Elsie Street, and running thence with the East side of Conestee Avenue, S. 27-10 W. 140 feet to an iron pin, corner of Lot No. 36; thence with the line of Lot No. 36; S. 62-50 E. 90 feet to a stake; corner of Lot No. 35; thence with the line of Lot No. 35, N. 27-10 E. 140 feet to an iron pin on the South side of Elsie Street; thence along the south side of Elsie Street, N. 62-50 W. 90 feet to the point of beginning."
