KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS THAT I, J. W. Norwood, Trustee for the Wilmington Savings & Trust Company, in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of Five Dollars,

to be paid by South Carolina Security Company, in the State aforesaid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release, unto the said South Carolina Security Company,

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, on the Anderson Road having the following, more or less, and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at an iron pin on said Anderson Road corner of the Virginia Carolina Chemical Company property, and running thence S. 47-20 E. 1256 feet to an iron pipe on the right of way of the Columbia and Greenville Division of the Southern Railroad; thence with said right of way of said railroad, S. 27-0 W. 399 feet; thence continuing with said right of way, S. 33-23 W. 304.5 feet to an iron pipe on line of the Wilmington Savings & Trust Company property; thence with the line of the said Wilmington Savings & Trust Company, N. 47-20 W. 1414 feet to an iron pipe on the Anderson Road; thence with the Anderson Road, N. 42-44 E. 684.5 feet to the beginning corner, and containing 20.50 acres as shown on a plat made by Dalton & Neves dated November 1934 and recorded in R. L. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book "H" at page 265.

For value received, the Wilmington Savings & Trust Company does hereby release and forever discharge the within described tract of land from the lien of that certain mortgage given by the Westview Land Company to the Wilmington Savings & Trust Company in the sum of \$36,000.00 dated December 1, 1928, and recorded in the R. L. C. Office for Greenville County in Mortgage Book, Vol. 195 at page 69.
