"All that piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the County and State aforesaid and being in Butler Township, containing 58 acres, more or less, and which is a part of the estate of the said J. N. Hudson, and is more fully represented by a plat of the lower tract made by Dalton and Nevas Engineers, September, 1933, said plat to be recorded and is hereby referred to as a part of this deed for a more complete description."
