all that piece or parcel or lot of land in Township Greenville County State of South Carolina.

All that certain tract, parcel of land in State and County aforesaid Highland Township being all of tract #2 according to plat of the property of D. W., B. F. and E. E. Reese made by H. S. Brockman, surveyor on December 2, 1928, and having the following metes and bounds to-wit:- Beginning at a point in the center of Fews Bridge road and runs thence N. 26-30 W. 841' feet to stake on branch; thence N. 88-08 W. 513' feet to three poplars on branch; thence N. 8 W. 207 feet to stake; thence N. 13-30 E. 143 feet to walnut tree (dead); thence N. 10-30 E. 182 feet to poplar 3x; thence N. 8-15 E. 207.5 feet to W. O., 3x; thence N. 9-05 E. 224 feet to poplar 3x; thence N. 9 W. 129 feet to stake; thence S. 59 W. 742 feet to stake in W. O.
