Beginning at a stake joint corners of lots Nos. 4, 5, 6 and 7 and running thence S. 56-30 W. 1074 feet to a stake, thence S. 35-15 E. 395 feet to a stake, thence N. 87-20 E. 1076 feet to a stake, thence N. 35-15 W. 409 feet to the beginning corner and containing 9.85 acres more or less.
