lying, being and situate on the south side of the National Highway, about 3 miles from Greenville Court House, having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at a pin in the intersection of the National Highway and the road leading toward White Oak Church and running thence along said highway S. 50-35 N. 100 ft. thence S. 54.20 N. 375 feet; thence S. 48.43 W. 96.5 feet; thence S. 23.50 E. 586.3 feet to a pipe; thence S. 6.0 S. 604 feet; thence S. 4.28 E. 1383.5 feet; thence S. 70.30 E. 486.3 feet to pipe; thence S. 11.40 W. 369.3 feet to a pipe; thence S. 77.20 E. 386.9 feet to a pin; thence N. 4.56 W. 2344.6 feet; thence N. 40.05 E. 18.5 feet; thence N. 39-15 W. 375 feet; thence N. 50 W. 444 feet; thence N. 50-20 W. 306.7 feet to the beginning corner, containing 42½ acres more or less, and being the same land conveyed to J.
