(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said

M. O. Drummond, her heirs and assigns, forever.

"All that tract, piece, or parcel of land, lying, being and situate in the Town of Fountain Inn, South Carolina, County of Greenville and State aforesaid, containing One and Sixty-seven/100 (1.67) acres, more or less, being a part of the James A. Cannon Place, in Fairview Township, Greenville County, and Beginning at an iron stake on Main Street at W. A. Givens' lot; running Main Street N. 63½ N. 1.86 to an iron stake at fork of Georgia Road; thence along Georgia Road S. 62½ W. 6.41 to iron stake on Georgia Road; thence S. 52 S. 3.91 to stake at W. A. Givens Lot; thence N. 32 S. 6.19 back to beginning corner on Main Street. This being surveyed by James A. Adams on the 14th day of October 1903. Bounded by Main Street on the North; by J. W. Givens on the West; on the South by lands of Garrett and McKeley; and on the East by lands of W. A. Givens."

Less However, The following described tract of land heretofore conveyed to me, J. C. Drummond, by M. O. Drummond;

"All that tract, piece, or parcel of land lying, being and situated in Fairview Township, County and State aforesaid, a lot with the following metes and bounds; to-wit: Beginning at an iron stake at back corner of my lot where the Street and the Georgia Road meet, running the Georgia Road N. 52½ W. 112 feet to iron pin; thence S. 37½ W. 112 feet to iron pin on my line; thence running S. 32 W. 40 feet to the Street; thence along the Street N. 52 W. 137 feet to the Georgia Road; the beginning corner. This lot being part of a plot of land conveyed to M. O. Drummond by deed of J. H. Drummond dated March 6th, 1908, and recorded in R. M. C. office in Greenville County in Volume WWW, at page 436. Bounded on the North by the Georgia Road; on the East by Mary O. Drummond's Home lot; on the South by Mary O. Drummond's lot; and on West by a Street running from Braig Street to the Georgia Road. "
