KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, Mrs. Dora D. Fowler, of Fountain Inn, S. C.

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said

Mrs. Marcelle B. Quillen, her heirs and assigns forever:
All that piece, parcel or lot of land, lying being and situate in the Town of Fountain Inn, on the Southwest side of Weston Street, state and County aforesaid, and in Fairview Township, Beginning at an iron fence post corner on the southwest side of sidewalk on West Street, near the Residence formerly occupied by Dr. A. L. Blanding, running thence in a Southwesterly direction along said fence eighty-five feet to alley; thence in a Southerly direction along said alley eighty-five feet to J. B. Hughes, corner; thence in a Northeasterly direction along Hughes line eighty-five feet to iron pin at sidewalk on Weston street; thence in a Northerly direction along sidewalk eighty-five feet to the beginning corner, iron fence post. This being composed of a part of Lot No. 56 & a part of Lot No. 55 as shown by a plat made by J. R. Hellams dated January 21, 1883, of which is in the keeping of the town of Fountain Inn. The Lot hereinbefore described was devised to me under the will of my late Husband, J. W. Fowler, deceased, which is duly recorded in the probate court for Greenville County in Apartment 300 file 6; bounded on the north by part of Lot No. 55, which belongs to me, on the East by Westonstreet, on the South by part of Lot No. 56; belonging to J. B. Hughes, on the west by 20 foot alley in the rear of Robert Quillen's residence.
