That lot of land near the City of Spartanburg, said County and State on the south
side of the new Howard Gap road, extending from that road westwardly to the old Howard Gap
road, with courses and distances shown in a deed of E. G. Henson to Thos. W. Lyles and J. C.
Daniel recorded in Vol. 7-A, page 2361, R. A. C. Office for said County, to which deed and
its record reference is made.

That lot in said County and State near Clifton No. 2, containing One Half acre,
more or less, bounded west by J. S. Manaffey, north by public road, and south by lands
