Agreement.

Whereas, the undersigned, S. R. Gaston, Carl Benson, W. L. Stamey, and Allen Drake, have installed a water line connecting with the main city water line, and leading into the town of Squeelers Rest, S.C., and in consideration of the mutual benefits to be derived herefrom by the undersigned, it is mutually understood and agreed that the total cost of the construction of said line and all future repairs thereto shall be borne equally between the undersigned.

It is further understood and agreed that no taps to said water line shall be sold, unless agreeable to all of the undersigned and in no event at a price less than \$100.00 cash for each tap and that the sale of each tap for said price above mentioned shall be for use in only one residence or one place of business and that if the person or persons purchasing said tap shall desire to extend their line to another lot, residence, or place of business that said extension shall constitute an additional tap for which shall be paid additional top fees of at least \$100.00 for each and every additional extension and that each tap shall be sold with the understanding that no person shall be allowed to connection with or construction any extension thereof.

It is further understood and agreed that each of the undersigned shall have the right to tap said water line free of charge for the purpose of obtaining water upon any property that they may own.

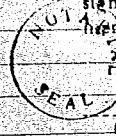
