

For And In Consideration of One Dollar (\$1.00), payment of which is hereby acknowledged, we the undersigned, J. F. White and Mrs. J. F. White, his wife, hereby grant and convey unto the Postal Telegraph Cable Company, its successors and assigns, the right privilege and authority to construct, operate and maintain its lines of Telegraph and Telephone, including the necessary poles, wires, cables and fixtures upon, over and across the land which we own, or in which we have an interest, in the County of Greenville, S. C., and State of S. C., which right-of-way may be identified as follows: North Side Carly Ramsey South Woodside Ave. East Bramlett Road West City View Water² Sewer District: one anchor, one guy, one anchor, one guy wire to be erected upon said Property (only) and upon and along the roads, streets or highways in front of or adjoining said land, with the right to permit the attachment of the wires and cables of any other company, and the right to trim any trees along said lines so as to keep the wires and cables cleared at least eighteen inches, and to erect and set the necessary guy and brace poles and anchors, and to attach thereto the necessary guy wires.
