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The above described tracts of land are the same conveyed to John D. Wood by W. Wier Davis by deed dated November 23, 1934, and recorded in the office of the Clerk of Court for Laurens County in Deed Book 66, page 448, and the same conveyed to the said John D. Wood by John D. Wood by deed dated October 18, 1933, and recorded in the office of the Clerk of Court for Laurens County in Deed Book 65, page 114.

It is the intent and purpose of this Agreement to cover all the property located in Greenville County of which the said John D. Wood died seized and possessed save and excepting that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the County and State aforesaid, in Chick Springs Township, in the Town of Greer, on the south side of Emma Street known as the homestead of the said John D. Wood, deceased, and all the property in the County of Laurens of which the said John D. Wood died seized and possessed.

II. Upon execution of the deed to the parties, the said Pearl Haynes Wood, Mae Wood Robison and Helen Wood Hendrix will have received property valued at eight thousand four hundred seventy-three and 33/100 (\$8,473.33) Dollars each, and each one agrees to sign and deliver to the executors of said estate a receipt for said amount which shall be charged against him or her in the final settlement of said estate.

III. It is further agreed that the above distribution made at the request of the parties hereto, shall be a full, complete and final settlement and division of all the real estate owned by the executors of said estate above described, which is covered by Item 7 of said will.
