and other obstructions that may in any way endanger the proper operation of same.

(b) That no pipe lines now or hereafter belonging to the grantor, its successors and assigns, shall at any time be overflowed or covered by back water nor shall any permanent structure of any character be erected over or on said water lines as now constructed or that may be hereafter constructed.

(c) That the grantor, its successors and assigns, servants, agents, employees and the Commissioners of Public Works of the City of Greenville, their servants, agents and employees, may at all times enter upon the property hereby conveyed for the purpose of and for laying new water pipes or for making repair to pipes now or hereafter laid, and to have foot and vehicular right-of-way over and across any of said property that may be necessary for ingress and egress to and from the property not herein conveyed but above described as being reserved.

(d) That said property shall be used only for State Park purposes; if at any time it is abandoned for such or used for any purpose inconsistent with such use, it shall thereupon revert to the grantor, its successors and assigns.

And the said granting corporation does hereby bind itself and its successors to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the grantee hereinabove named and its successors, against itself and its successors.

In witness whereof the said granting corporation has caused its corporate seal to be hereunto affixed and these presents to be subscribed by its duly authorized officers, John McHardy Mauldin, Mayor, and B. F. Dillard, City Clerk and Treasurer, on this the 7th day of August, in the year of our Lord one thousand, nine hundred and thirty-five and in the one hundred and sixtieth year of the sovereignty and independence of the United States of America.
