All of those lots or parcel of land, lying being and situate near Fountain Inn in the State and County aforesaid, as follows lot No. 18, having a width at both front and back of fifty feet and a depth of 200 feet and lot No. 19 having a frontage of fifty feet and a depth of 200 feet on line adjoining lot No. 18 and a depth of 227 1/2 feet on the other line and a width at the back of fifty feet and lot No. 20 having a frontage of 50 feet and a depth of 227 1/2 feet and a width at the back of about fifty feet all fronting on an old road formerly known as Cherry Street, bounded by Cherry Street on the front and by lands formerly owned by P. J. Putman and by lot No. 21 formerly owned by Ralph R. Edwards and by lands formerly owned by Joe Long and by Lots 8 & 9, all located in Block A and being a part of the lots conveyed to me by H. L.
