J. B. Castellor, his heirs and assigns forever,
all that certain piece, parcel, lot or tract of
land, lying situate and being in Greenville Town-
ship, Walhalla County, South Carolina, located
on the north side of Parker Road, about two and
one-half miles from Greenville County Courthouse,
and being known and designated as tract no. 2
of the property of the estate of J. C. Martin, plat
dated January 2, 1929, made by C. M. Furman,
Jr. and containing six acres, more or less, and
being more particularly described as follows:

Beginning in the center of Parker Road, joint
corner of tract no. 1, and running thence with
joint line of tracts nos. 1 and 2 N. 44 E. 12.20
chains, thence N. 52.15 W. 1.68 chains, thence N.
80.15 E. 1.38 chains, thence N. 55.20 W. 1.80 chains
to corner of tract no. 2, J. C. Martin, estate, thence
with joint line of tracts nos. 2 and 3 S. 51.35 W.
12.26 chains to center of said Road, thence S.
59.45 E. 6.06 chains to the point of beginning, and
