sum of One hundred (\$100.00) Dollars
to me paid by the said F. D. Alexander

the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, HAVE GRANTED, bargained, sold, and released, and by these Presents DO GRANT, bargain, sell and release unto
the said F. D. Alexander,

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land in the County and State aforesaid,
about two miles west of the County Court House in a sub-division known and designated as
"City View", a plat of which is recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in
Plat Book "A", Page 460 and 461, and being known and designated as lot 46 thereon, and
having a frontage of 50 feet on the east side of Henderson Street, and running back in
parallel lines 150 feet to a 10 foot alley. Being the same property conveyed to Lillie
May White by J. W. Lipscombe by his deed dated April 8, 1925, and recorded in the R.M.C.
