WHEREAS, J. K. Huff

on or about the 2nd day of January in the year of our Lord nineteen hundred and thirty four exhibited his complaint in the Court of Common Pleas for the County aforesaid, against Harry Sullivan, et al.

demanding judgment in relation to the real estate hereinafter mentioned and described; and the cause being at issue, came on to be heard on the X day of X, 19 , and such proceedings were had therein as resulted in a Decree

of the said Court, whereby it was adjudged and decreed that the said real estate hereinafter mentioned and described be sold by E. INMAN, Master in and for the County aforesaid, on the terms and for the purposes mentioned in the said decree, as by reference thereto on file in said Court will appear; and the Master, after having duly advertised the said real estate

for the sum of Five hundred (\$500,00) Dollars, being at that price the highest bidder therefor.

NOW, THEREFORE, Know All Men by These Presents, That I, E. INMAN, Master in and for the County of Greenville aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of Five hundred (\$500.00) Dollars to me paid by the said Sudie Rebecca Huff

the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, HAVE GRANTED, bargained, sold, and released, and by these Presents DO GRANT, bargain, sell and release unto the said Sudie Rebecca Huff

"All that tract or parcel of land, situate, lying and being in Greenville County and State aforesaid, containing 17½ acres, more or less, and bounded by lands of R. L. Holcombe on the North, and on the East by lands of Sam Kellett and on the south by lands of Walcomb Meadows, and on the West by Ben Evans, and being a part of the J. W. Huff estate, and being the same conveyed to Harry Sullivan by J. K. Huff by deed bearing date of April 30, 1921. Also, all that other tract or parcel of land situate, lying and being in Greenville County and State aforesaid, containing 46½ acres, more or less, and bounded by lands of R. L. Holcombe and the old Georgia Road on the North, on the South by lands of Sam Kellett and on the West by lands of Young Jackson, on the East by the Reedy River, and also being a part of the old J. W. Huff property, and being the same lands conveyed to Harry Sullivan by John Chiles by deed dated December 3, 1914. "
