WHEREAS, L. O. Lohmann

on or about the 21st day of March in the year of our Lord nineteen hundred and thirty five exhibited his complaint in the Court of Common Pleas for the County aforesaid, against Central Agencies Co. corporation, et al.

demanding judgment in relation to the real estate hereinafter mentioned and described; and the cause being at issue, came on to be heard on the 10th day of May, 1935, and such proceedings were had therein as resulted in a Decree

NOW, THEREFORE, Know All Men by These Presents, That I, E. INMAN, Master in and for the County of Greenville aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of One hundred (\$100.00) Dollars to me paid by the said Mrs. Mabry R. Gillespie

the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, HAVE GRANTED, bargained, sold, and released, and by these Presents DO GRANT, bargain, sell and release unto the said Mrs. Mabry R. Gillespie

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, situate, lying and being in Greenville County, State of South Carolina, known and designated as Lot No. 85 North Hills Property of Title Guarantee and Trust Company, as shown in Plat Book H, Page 138, recorded in R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, said lot being on the east side of McDonald Street and having the following metes and bounds:

Beginning at an iron pin on McDonald Street, 480.2 feet from the intersection of McDonald Street and Gallivan Avenue, and running thence along McDonald Street N. 23-32 E. 70.2 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 71-43 E. 198.3 feet to an iron pin on a 20-foot alley; thence S. 18-34 W. 70 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 71-43 W. 204.3 feet to beginning corner on McDonald Street."
