the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, HAVE GRANTED, bargained, sold, and released, and by these Presents DO GRANT, bargain, sell and release unto  
the said Lulie L. Wood.

"All that tract or lot of land in Chick Springs Township, Greenville County,  
State of South Carolina, having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at a stake at the intersection of Emma Street and Miller Street and  
runs thence with Miller Street N. 73 $\frac{1}{2}$  W. 200 feet to a stake; thence S. 16 $\frac{1}{2}$  W. 100 feet to  
a stake; thence S. 73 $\frac{3}{4}$  E. 200 feet to a stake on Emma Street; thence N. 16 $\frac{1}{2}$  E. 100 feet  
to the beginning corner, and containing 46/100 acres, more or less, and described as Lot
