WHEREAS *J. W. Norwood*

on or about the *19th* day of *March* in the year of our Lord nineteen hundred and *thirty - five* exhibited *his* complaint in the Court of Common Pleas for the County aforesaid against

*Lindy Burton and Prudence Burton*

demanding judgment in relation to the real estate hereinafter mentioned and described; and the cause being at issue, came on to be heard on the *24th* day of *March* 19*35* and such proceedings were had therein as resulted in a Decree

of the said Court, whereby it was adjudged and decreed that the said real estate hereinafter mentioned and described be sold by E. INMAN, Master in and for the County aforesaid, on the terms and for the purposes mentioned in the said decree, as by reference thereto on file in said Court will appear; and the Master, after having duly advertised the said real estate

NOW THEREFORE, Know All Men by These Presents, That I, E. INMAN, Master in and for the County of Greenville aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of *One Hundred (\$100.00)* Dollars to me paid by the said *J. W. Norwood, as Trustee, as aforesaid,*

the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, HAVE GRANTED, bargained, sold, and released, and by these Presents DO GRANT, bargain, sell and release unto the said *J. W. Norwood, as Trustee, as aforesaid,*

"All that certain lot of land in Greenville Township, State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, on the western side of Mr. Leod Street (formerly known as Greene Avenue) in the City of Greenville, being Lot No. 61, of 'Washington Heights' subdivision according to a plat made by C. M. Furman, Jr., February 3, 1922, and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book 'F', Page 54; said lot fronting 35 feet on Mr. Leod Street and having a depth of 87.5 feet, and the same lot of land conveyed to Grant Burton and Lindy Burton, by the Norwood National Bank as Trustee by deed dated *May 26, 1924.*"
