the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, HAVE GRANTED, bargained, sold, and released, and by these Presents DO GRANT, bargain, sell and release unto the said *Thomas W. Edwards*.

All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Austin Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, adjoining lands of J. W. Blakely, Mrs. Maggie Sargent, et al, described as follows:
