I, E. INMAN, Master in and for the County aforesaid, SEND GREETINGS:

WHEREAS, George Norwood, as Conservator of
the People's Building and Loan Association,
a corporation

on or about the 13th day of July, in the year of
 our Lord nineteen hundred and thirty-six exhibited his complaint in the Court of
 Common Pleas for the County aforesaid, against Mary Burk Smith, et al,

NOW, THEREFORE, Know All Men by These Presents, That I, E. INMAN, Master in and for the County of Greenville aforesaid, in consideration of the
 sum of One Hundred (\$100.00) Dollars
 to me paid by the said Jamie C. Ginson

the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, HAVE GRANTED, bargained, sold, and released, and by these Presents DO GRANT, bargain, sell and release unto
 the said Jamie C. Ginson

"All that certain piece parcel or lot
 of land lying, being, and situate in
 Greenville County, in the State of South
 Carolina, as follows to-wit:

Being known and designated as lot No. 6
 of the C. P. Martine property, on the West side
 of Macannow Street, as shown on a plat of said
 property recorded in the office of the R. M. C. for
 Greenville County in Plat Book F, page 102,
 described as follows:

Beginning at an iron pin on Mac-
 annow Street, point corner of Lots Nos. 6 and
 7, running thence with line of Lot No. 7
 N. 71-35 W. 183.4 feet; thence N. 16-51 E. 69.9 feet to
 next joint corner of Lots Nos. 5 and 6; thence
