I, E. INMAN, Master in and for the County aforesaid, SEND GREETINGS:

WHEREAS, *George Norwood, as Conservator of the Peoples Building and Loan Association*

on or about the *30th* day of *April* in the year of our Lord nineteen hundred and *thirtysix* exhibited *his* complaint in the Court of Common Pleas for the County aforesaid, against *George Dewey Booker and A. C. Mc Bain*

demanding judgment in relation to the real estate hereinafter mentioned and described; and the cause being at issue, came on to be heard on the *16th* day of *June*, 19*36* and such proceedings were had therein as resulted in a *Decree*

NOW, THEREFORE, Know All Men by These Presents, That I, E. INMAN, Master in and for the County of Greenville aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of *One Hundred (\$100.00)* Dollars to me paid by the said *Henry P. Millimon*

the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, HAVE GRANTED, bargained, sold, and released, and by these Presents DO GRANT, bargain, sell and release unto the said *Henry P. Millimon*

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land lying, being situate in Greenville County, State of South Carolina, as follows; known as Lot No. 3 of the property of A. C. Mc Bain, as shown on plat of said property, not recorded, said plat having been made by C. M. Furman, Jr., Engineer, November 11, 1927, said lot has a frontage of 42 feet on the Old Spartanburg Road and runs back in parallel lines 109 feet, being on the north side of said Old Spartanburg Road.
