I, E. INMAN, Master in and for the County aforesaid, SEND GREETINGS:

WHEREAS,

*J. Rolfe Babb, Attorney*

on or about the *2nd* day of *August* in the year of our Lord nineteen hundred and *thirtysix* exhibited *his* complaint in the Court of Common Pleas for the County aforesaid, against

*Harris Addison, Attorney in fact for Annie R. Addison, et al,*

demanding judgment in relation to the real estate hereinafter mentioned and described; and the cause being at issue, came on to be heard on the *16th* day of *September*, 19*36*, and such proceedings were had therein as resulted in a Decree

of the said Court, whereby it was adjudged and decreed that the said real estate hereinafter mentioned and described be sold by E. INMAN, Master in and for the County aforesaid, on the terms and for the purposes mentioned in the said decree, as by reference thereto on file in said Court will appear; and the Master, after having duly advertised the said real estate

for sale by public outcry on the *5th* day of *October* in the year of our Lord nineteen hundred and *thirtysix*, did then openly and publicly, according to the custom of auctions, sell and dispose of the same unto

*Keyward Roberts Addison and William Harris Addison*

for the sum of *One Hundred (\$100.00)* Dollars, being at that price the highest bidder therefor.

NOW, THEREFORE, Know All Men by These Presents, That I, E. INMAN, Master in and for the County of Greenville aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of *One Hundred (\$100.00)* Dollars to me paid by the said *Keyward Roberts Addison and William Harris Addison*

the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, HAVE GRANTED, bargained, sold, and released, and by these Presents DO GRANT, bargain, sell and release unto the said *Keyward Roberts Addison and William Harris Addison.*

"All that certain lot situats in Ward One Of the City of Greenville, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, on the West side of David Street, having the following metes and bounds:

Beginning at a stake on the west side of David Street, at the corner of lot belonging to H. D. Grant and others, and thence running along the line of David Street, N. 24 1/2 W. 85 feet to a stake on the line of W. P. Tiedeman; thence along the Tiedeman line S. 37 W. 195 feet to a stake in the line of property now or formerly owned by Crystal Williams; thence along the Williams and Altom line S. 34 E. 85 feet to a stake; on the Grant line; thence along the Grant line N. 56 1/2 E. 180 feet to the beginning corner on David Street, and being the same lot conveyed to Annie R.
