I, E. INMAN, Master in and for the County aforesaid, SEND GREETINGS:

the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, HAVE GRANTED, bargained, sold, and released, and by these Presents DO GRANT bargain, sell and release unto the said *B. B. Waters and The First National Bank of Greenville as Executors of the Estate of R. D. Dobson*
