TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS SHALL COME:

I, E. INMAN, Master in and for the County aforesaid, SEND GREETINGS:

WHEREAS, *George Norwood, as Conservator of the Peoples Building and Loan Association, a Corporation*

on or about the *20th* day of *October* in the year of our Lord nineteen hundred and *thirty-six* exhibited *his* complaint in the Court of Common Pleas for the County aforesaid, against *Mary J. Harris and Nellie Fisher*

demanding judgment in relation to the real estate hereinafter mentioned and described; and the cause being at issue, came on to be heard on the *18th* day of *December*, 19*36*, and such proceedings were had therein as resulted in a _____ Decree

of the said Court, whereby it was adjudged and decreed that the said real estate hereinafter mentioned and described be sold by E. INMAN, Master in and for the County aforesaid, on the terms and for the purposes mentioned in the said decree, as by reference thereto on file in said Court will appear; and the Master, after having duly advertised the said real estate

for the sum of *One Hundred (\$100.00)* Dollars, being at that price the highest bidder thereof.

NOW, THEREFORE, Know All Men by These Presents, That I, E. INMAN, Master in and for the County of Greenville aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of *One Hundred (\$100.00)* Dollars to me paid by the said *J. G. Scott*

the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, HAVE GRANTED, bargained, sold, and released, and by these Presents DO GRANT, bargain, sell and release unto the said *J. G. Scott*.

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land on Parker Street, near Buncombe Street in the City of Greenville, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, described as follows:

Beginning at a point on Parker Street, corner of a twenty foot alley, running thence with said twenty foot alley, S. W. 116 feet to Lidie Williams' line; thence with her line, S. W. 46 feet and 2 inches; thence N. W. parallel with the first line mentioned above, 116 feet to Parker Street; thence with Parker Street, N. E. 46 feet and 2 inches to the beginning corner. This lot contains 5355 square feet, more or less."
