An agreement, made and entered into this the 23 day of January, 1936, by and between the Duke Power Company, a corporation duly organized and existing under and by virtue of the laws of the State of Delaware, hereinafter for convenience styled the Power Company, party of the first part, and, Parker Waterford Sewer District of Greenville, S.C., a corporation organized and existing under and by virtue of the laws of the State of South Carolina, hereinafter for convenience styled the Sewer District, party of the second part;

Witnesseth: That the Power Company, for and in consideration of the covenants of the Sewer District, hereinafter expressed, hereby gives and grants unto the Sewer District, determinable as hereinafter expressed, the license or privilege to construct and maintain water mains and pipes across its right of way and under its car tracks near the City of Greenville, in the State and County aforesaid at the following designated points:

1. A 24-inch galvanized iron pipe, at the point where Martine Street intersects Bradley Street in San Saba.
2. A 6-inch cast iron pipe at the point where 771st Cross Street intersects Bradley Street in San Saba.
